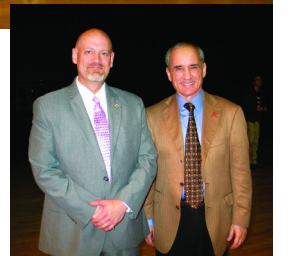
Life Without God is a Picnic
